



## **MEDIA INFORMATION FOR APEC**

**SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA  
SEPTEMBER 11-26, 2011**

**\*\*PRESS REGISTRATION AUGUST 15 – 29\*\***

The State Department is now accepting media registration applications for the APEC Ministerial meetings in San Francisco, California. The Third APEC Senior Officials Meeting and related Meetings (SOM 3) will take place September 11-26, 2011, at the Hyatt Regency Embarcadero and the Westin St. Francis hotels. All media covering the meetings must hold a valid registration pass.

Register using the Press Registration Application Form at <https://press.state.gov/APEC/>. **The deadline to submit press registration applications is MONDAY, AUGUST 29, 2011 (11:59 p.m. EST).**

Please note that this application is for media registration only. Official photographers who are travelling with their country's delegation are required to contact their embassy for credential applications.

**Your registration will not be processed if the required information and format are incorrect.**

**Note:** Journalists who are not American citizens and are issued a registration pass must have a valid "I" visa or work permit ("Green Card") to work in the United States, even for a short period. Please consult the U.S. Embassy or Consulate closest to you about obtaining an "I" visa.

Registered members of the press may pick up their registration pass starting Tuesday, September 13. Times and location will be announced soon.

There will be a press filing center at the Hyatt Regency Embarcadero hotel open from September 14-17, 2011. Only registered members of the press will be allowed access to the filing center and press events.

**Note that while many official Ministerial press events will be open press coverage, some may be pooled; however, any media outlet will be able to access all APEC host video at no cost for their broadcast purposes via an FTP site to be identified in a later media note. APEC host video will also be provided to APTN, Reuters and Eurovision.**

All journalists registered to cover the Ministerial meetings can cover the open press events. The official media program is listed later in this note. There may be additional media events sponsored by individual economies/Ministers. These will be announced throughout the Ministerial meeting.

### **About SOM 3**

SOM 3 will help lay the groundwork for the APEC Economic Leaders' Meeting in Honolulu in November. Meetings at SOM 3 will focus on further promoting regional economic integration, developing green growth throughout the member economies, and encouraging regional cooperation and convergence. Provide the reception with the guest name, requested type of room (i.e. king, double/double) check-in and check-out dates. A credit card will be required to reserve a room.

#### ***Harbor Court Hotel:***

The hotel is in the Financial District on the waterfront, about two blocks from the Hyatt Regency, one of the SOM 3 venues and where the press filing center will be located. Room availability is limited and reservations are required.
